


Today the Church celebrates the end of the church's liturgical year as we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. We hear in today's Gospel overtones of Christ's passion. This Gospel reading shows who we are to be Christians. Just as Christ did not respond to the soldiers who taunted him, we are to turn the other cheek.
