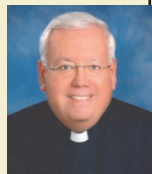
Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Welcome to November! This weekend is special to our community as we pause and recognize at the Saturday evening Mass all those who have died since *All Souls Day* of 2018. In particular, we recognize members of our community who have gone to the Lord during the past year. Our Church has traditionally set aside this day, November 2, for those who at their death were not yet opened completely to God's will. We pray that they will be purified, have eternal life, and be raised on the last day.

We hear in today's Gospel the wonderful story of Zacchaeus. One can imagine his joy when Jesus sees him! But the story does not end with this tax collector's rejoicing. The next verses tell of the change of heart that Zacchaeus experienced. Not only did he say he would give half his possessions to the poor but he would repay fourfold anyone he had extorted.

Upon encountering Jesus, Zacchaeus was able to detach from his possessions. In the Word and Eucharist, we also meet Jesus. Have those encounters prompted you to detach from any possessions or change in any way?

Let us pray. God our loving Father, you bring us to newness of life. Guide along the paths of holiness your people searching for meaning, so that they may come to rejoice in their ever deeper relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

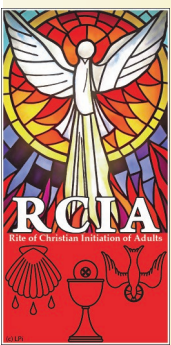


Imagine God coming to you at this very moment saying, “Today I must stay at your house!” How do you react when you hear those words? God must stay at your house. There is no time to clean or organize things or make any preparations. There is no time to backtrack and catch up on things that may have slipped by during the week. God is coming and doesn’t care how things look! God just wants to spend time with you. God’s mercy is very wide. It is so wide that we sometimes have a difficulty accepting just how unconditional and free it really is. We may find ourselves thinking that there must be some folks who don’t deserve it or aren’t worthy. All are worthy. The book of Wisdom tells us, “But you have mercy on all and you overlook people’s sins that they may repent.” There is no way around it: God must offer mercy. We are lost and we desperately need it.

News on the Work of the People

What is a Requiem? A Requiem is a Mass for the repose of the souls of the dead. It is also a musical composition setting parts of a requiem Mass, for example Mozart Requiem, or Faure Requiem. It is offered for the repose of the soul or souls of one or more deceased persons. The Mass and its settings draw their name from the introit of the liturgy, which begins with the words "Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domine" – "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord." Want to experience a Requiem? Come to Mass Saturday November 2 at 4:30pm for the Faure Requiem in its liturgical setting!
