

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Welcome to November! This weekend is special to our community as we pause and recognize at the Saturday evening Mass all those who have died since All Souls Day of 2018. In particular, we recognize members of our community who have gone to the Lord during the past year. Our Church has traditionally set aside this

day, November 2, for those who at their death were not yet opened completely to God's will. We pray that they will be purified, have eternal life, and be raised on the last day.

We hear in today's Gospel the wonderful story of Zacchaeus. One can imagine his joy when Jesus sees him! But the story does not end with this tax collector's rejoicing. 

<u>What is a Requiem?</u> A Requiem is a Mass for the repose of the souls of the dead. It is also a musical composition setting parts of a requiem Mass, for example Mozart Requiem, or Faure Requiem. It is offered for the repose of the soul or souls of one or more deceased persons. The Mass and its settings draw their name from the introit of the liturgy, which begins with the words "*Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domine*" – "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord." 


