



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

A Blessed and Joyful Advent! With today's celebration of the First Sunday of Advent, we enter the most joyful time of the year. Why? Because we soon celebrate the birth of Jesus, our



Redeemer and Savior. We also call to mind the return of Jesus at the end of all time. *Come, Lord Jesus!*

The Advent scriptures we hear beginning today are filled with promise and hope! Isaiah proclaims that the Lord will come to dwell among the chosen people. ATTENTION, "BABY-BOOMERS" FROM THE 1950'S AND 1960'S: Some may recall watching the-then "black and white TV" to get a glimpse of Bishop Fulton J. Sheen. He was the first bishop ever to utilize the television as a means of Catholic evangelization. He commanded a world-wide audience and was respected by Catholics and non-Catholics alike for his spirituality and oratory. The Vatican announced on November 18 that Bishop Sheen will be beatified and pronounced "Blessed" on December 21 at St. Mary's Cathedral, Peoria, IL, where he was ordained a priest and is now buried. The Rite of Beatification by the Church is the final stage prior to being proclaimed a saint.
