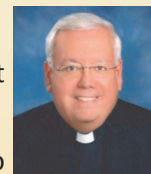

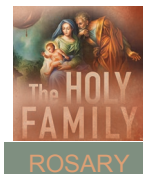

INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK



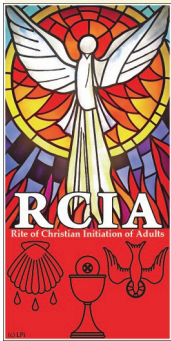

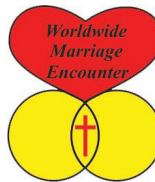

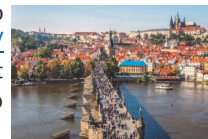
