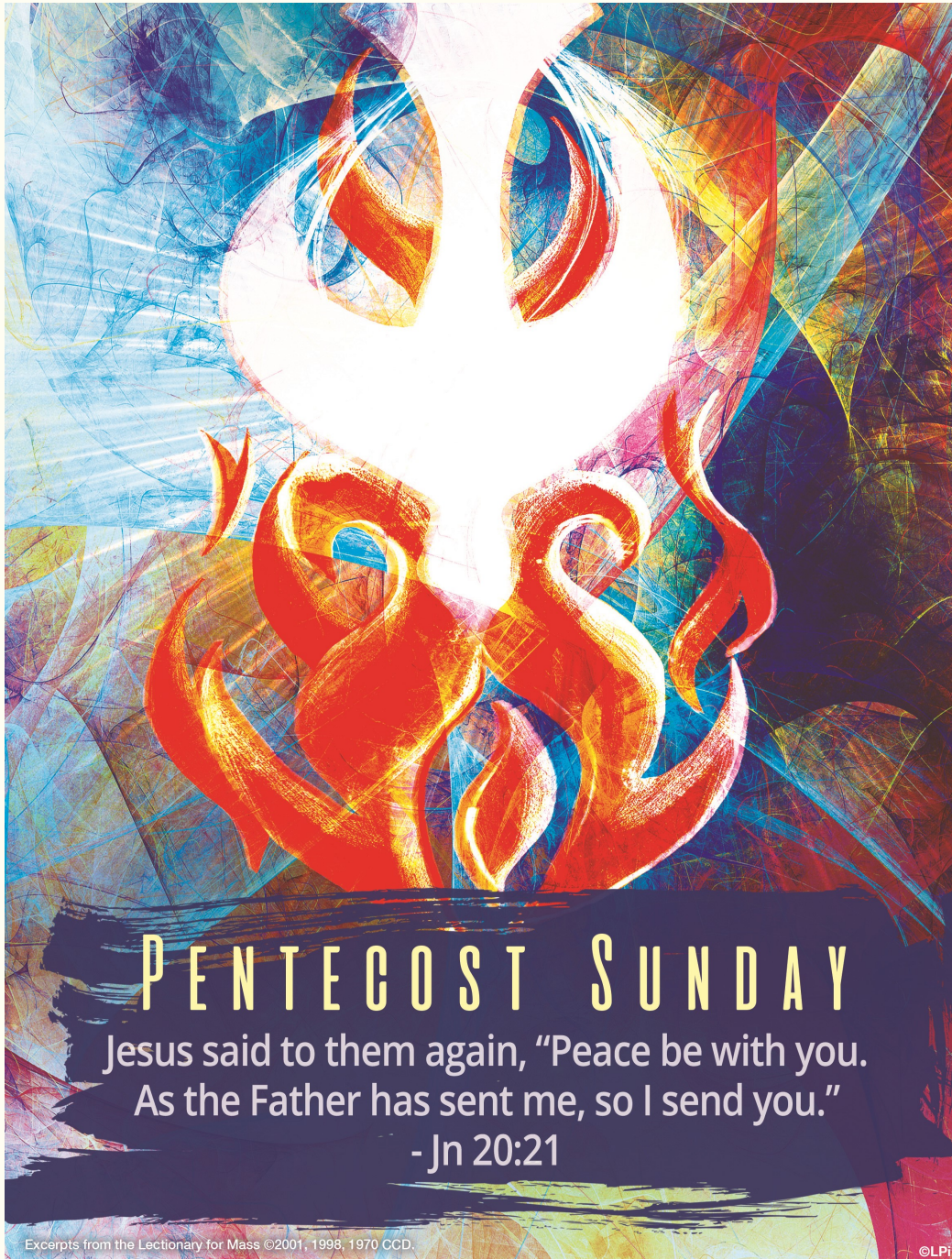

A very long time ago, a small group of nomads wandered through the desert after escaping slavery from Egypt. They were united together by blood, by tradition, but especially they were united by God under the law given to them through Moses.

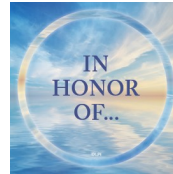

A reminder that when a parish exceeds its goal, 50% of the donations “over goal” are returned to the parish. Last year, the Archdiocese started this “rebate” program. Last year, our community exceeded the 2022 goal. Jesus the Good Shepherd received back \$7,136. This first rebate has been applied to the purchase of new rectangular tables in the Centre to replace the old, beat-up, heavy tables. They will be replaced in July with new light-weight rectangular tables which will go with the new round tables in the Centre.

Given our large facility, there are always upgrades, repairs and maintenance needed. Those needs are endless. So, your support of the *Annual Appeal* not only helps directly the outreach ministries of the Archdiocese of Washington but also helps us out here with our needs at Jesus the Good Shepherd. 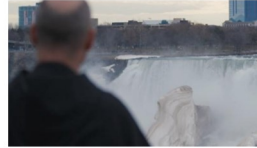
