NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

What a wonderful weekend last weekend with the ordination of parishioner, Deacon Mike Dorsett, to the permanent diaconate at the Basilica in Washington. To Deacon Mike and his wonderful family go our community's fondest congratulations, prayers and best wishes! I am also happy to share that Deacon Mike has been assigned by Cardinal Gregory to Jesus the Good Shepherd. This is certainly a "win-win" – both for him and for our community.

On to this weekend as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ [Corpus Christi]. The Eucharist has been celebrated from the very beginning as Christ commanded.

St. Paul in today's second reading writes to the Corinthians to correct abuses – yes, even in the first century – that were corrupting the unity that the Eucharist produces. When we share our Eucharistic Lord in consecrated bread and wine, we are part of the Body of Christ: the body of Christ gathered with his disciples more than two thousand years ago and the body of Christ that has gathered, continues to gather in Rome, Ethiopia, India, Peru, and in all parts of the world. Simply amazing!

This Eucharistic sharing gathers each of us in a very real way. By sharing in the Eucharist, we are transformed and this union with Christ, requires us to serve others pouring ourselves out as love in the world. This is how we "receive" blessing and "become" blessings to others.

Let us pray. *We bless you, most holy God, for you appeared to Abraham at table, you offered yourself in the last supper, you appeared in the breaking of bread at Emmaus, you reveal yourself in the breaking of the bread at each Eucharistic celebration. Make us ever worthy of your presence in us and in those we meet. Nourish and strengthen us in unity through the gifts of your Body and Blood. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

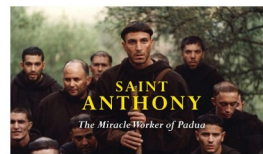
