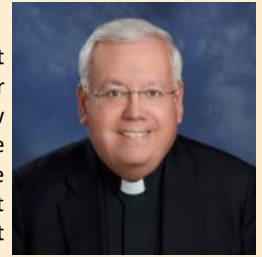

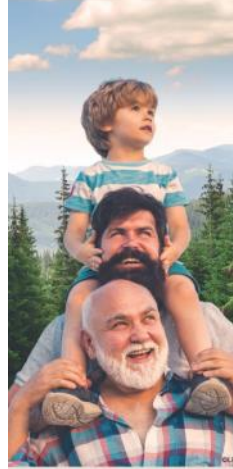
## Baptism Retreat June 25th!

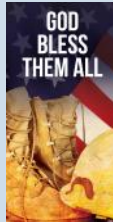

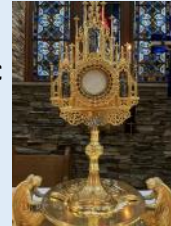
