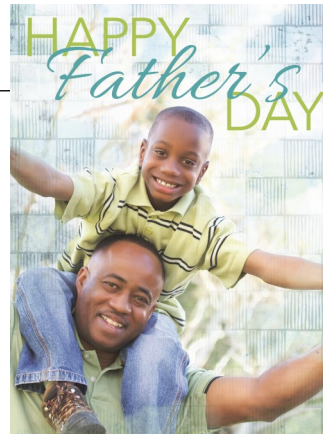

How is JGS keeping you safe?

Father Mike is ultimately concerned with the safety and well being of our community. We have made necessary precautions and followed local county and state guidelines during the re-opening of the church. We also listened to our parishioners and valued your answers to our questions a couple of weeks ago about where you would feel the most safe when Mass resumes. We have trained volunteers from our parish continuing to sanitize after Masses (if you would like to volunteer, let the church office know, we could use more help).

How should you and your family prepare?

1.) Make your reservation, choose:

- 4:30 p.m. Saturday Vigil Mass in the church (seating begins at 4:10 p.m.)
- 8:00 a.m. Mass in the church (seating begins at 7:40)
- 9:45 a.m. Outdoor Mass (choose from 3 options)
  - Pavilion Family Table (limited to 16)
  - Field
  - Car (limited to 20)

For you and the safety of our parishioners, reservations are required. This allows us to contact you should we have a need.

2.) Arrive early and prepared.

Follow all directions from our Host Team.

Please note:

- Wear a mask
- Social Distance
- Bring a lawn chair if reserved for the Field
- Access to bathrooms is limited
- Tune to FM 100.1 for Car listening (limited spots)
- Hospitality after Mass is temporarily unavailable

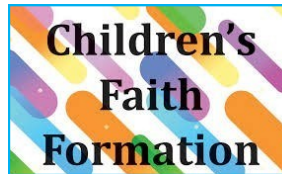

**LIVE THE LITURGY INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK**

Jesus knows that the challenges a disciple of the Gospel will face in the world are real. He tells all of us point blank, "Do not be afraid." There are many things we can fear as we attempt to live the Gospel: unpopularity, being rebuked, rejection, anger, being challenged, having to defend ourselves, standing alone, insecurity, failure, and even death. Many folks know that their faith calls them to live life more deliberately and radically but are cowards when it comes to putting it into practice. We easily justify sticking with the "acceptable" norms with which we are accustomed. These only serve to keep us stuck and mired in mediocrity. The Gospel — given flesh by the very presence of Christ — seeks to stretch, challenge, and change us. We do not have to fear anything, even death. Sometimes, living with our fears brings us a sadly disordered sense of comfort. Maybe what we really fear above all else is change. ©LPI
