Dear Community Members,



What a joy it was last Sunday to have celebrated two Masses – one virtual and the other our first public Mass -- which was outdoors at the Pavilion. We were also doubly-blessed with great attendance at both. In particular, I was so proud of our team who worked so hard in making sure we had a beautiful celebration outdoors. It was a beautiful day on top of it, and made the celebration of Pentecost that much more memorable and joyful. To God be the glory!

These two Masses are just a few of the many “glimmers of hope” which radiate from Jesus the Good Shepherd during the pandemic. To be sure, this period in which we are now in has been a time of adjustment, turmoil and uncertainty. But it is through the gestures of goodness and generosity experienced at Jesus the Good Shepherd by such things as our Masses we can all experience again, as I call them, “glimmers of hope.” Certainly, with God’s grace, the “glimmers of hope” will indeed increase!

Together with the resourcefulness of our dedicated staff, the use of technology, huge doses of creativity and the generosity of parishioners like you, Jesus the Good Shepherd continues our mission of bringing light and hope to our community and beyond. Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity – three Divine Persons in one God. The Scriptures, however, further reveal that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit cannot be understood apart from their unity.

We are initiated into that union at Baptism, and at that moment we no longer exist in isolation but are joined with the communion of saints; we become members of a body which we call the Body of Christ. Every time we say the name of the Trinity we affirm this truth.

*Let us pray. God our Father, you have sent your Son into the world for the salvation of all people; and through the power of the Holy Spirit, you have lifted up all nations to your glory. Grant that every believer bring this good news to the ends of the earth, “In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.” Amen!*

### How is JGS keeping you safe?

Father Mike is ultimately concerned with the safety and well being of our community. We have made necessary precautions and followed local county and state guidelines during the re-opening of the church. We also listened to our parishioners and valued your answers to our questions a couple of weeks ago about where you would feel the most safe when Mass resumes. We have trained volunteers from our parish continuing to sanitize after Masses (if you would like to volunteer, let the church office know, we could use more help).

### How should you and your family prepare?

1.) Make your reservation and choose your option for either the 8:00 a.m. Mass or the outdoor Pavilion Mass at 9:45 a.m. For the pavilion Mass you have 3 options: Pavilion Family Table, Field, or Car (limited). For you and the safety of our parishioners, reservations are required. This allows us to contact you should we have a need.

2.) Arrive early and prepared. Seating begins at 7:40 for the 8:00 a.m. Mass or 11:10 for the 11:30am Mass. Follow all directions from our Host Team.

- Wear a mask
- Social Distance
- Bring a lawn chair if reserved for the Field
- Bathrooms are unavailable
- Tune to FM 100.1 for Car listening (limited spots)
- Hospitality after Mass is temporarily unavailable
