



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope summer at this stage finds you well!

What a great image in today's gospel: the parable about the sower and the seed. Many of us enjoy planting vegetables, shrubs and flowers -- so today's gospel is so easy for us to absorb.

There might be a temptation to look around you and at others and wonder what kind of "soil" both you and your neighbors are planted in! When I was in grade school, I remember some classmates whom I incorrectly labeled as growing in "rocky ground." I didn't think that they would amount to anything. But POOF! As they have grown, their lives of faith have grown and today they are well rooted and bear great fruit. They are active and committed Catholics!

This parable of the sower and the seed invites us to consider how faith has been planted first within ourselves, then our families and our communities. 


