Dear Members and Visitors of our Community,

I recently read an article on our times stating that so many adult Catholics are busy and see the practice of their faith as a weighty burden. For starters, people are too busy to get to Mass. Perhaps part of the blame lies with those who have passed on the faith [or not passed on the faith] to them. If our Catholic faith is just a matter of precepts and rules, no wonder many see our faith as a great burden, borne simply to “get to heaven.” It is hard to be comforted and uplifted by such a vision. But the fact is that faith is so much more than this.

Faith gives us a vision of life and its meaning for us. Faith is the story of God’s amazing love, a treasure found in a field, a pearl of great price. In practicing our faith and in living a moral life, we are grateful to God, the example of whose Son we try to bring to life. In times of tragedy, we are consoled by the fact that God’s Son endured more than his share of the same. We are comforted and also enlightened by the mystery of God’s inner life.

Scripture, the Bible, tells us that we are now part of the family of God. We realize that religion is also a family affair. We all have difficulties with our Church in one way or another. But this is never a reason to separate us from Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We may even have moved away from it for a certain period of time in our lives. But when all is said and done, we know that without the Eucharist, we would be immensely poorer. We all need the Eucharist, we are all imperfect human beings, we are all in need of healing -- all year along.

Let us pray. *O God of wonder and majesty, after each of day of creation, you declared its goodness. During these weeks of summer, remind us to celebrate the goodness of your creation, which is full of beautiful colors, flavors, textures, smells, sounds and sights. Fill our hearts with a desire to always give you honor and praise for the many gifts you have given us. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.*

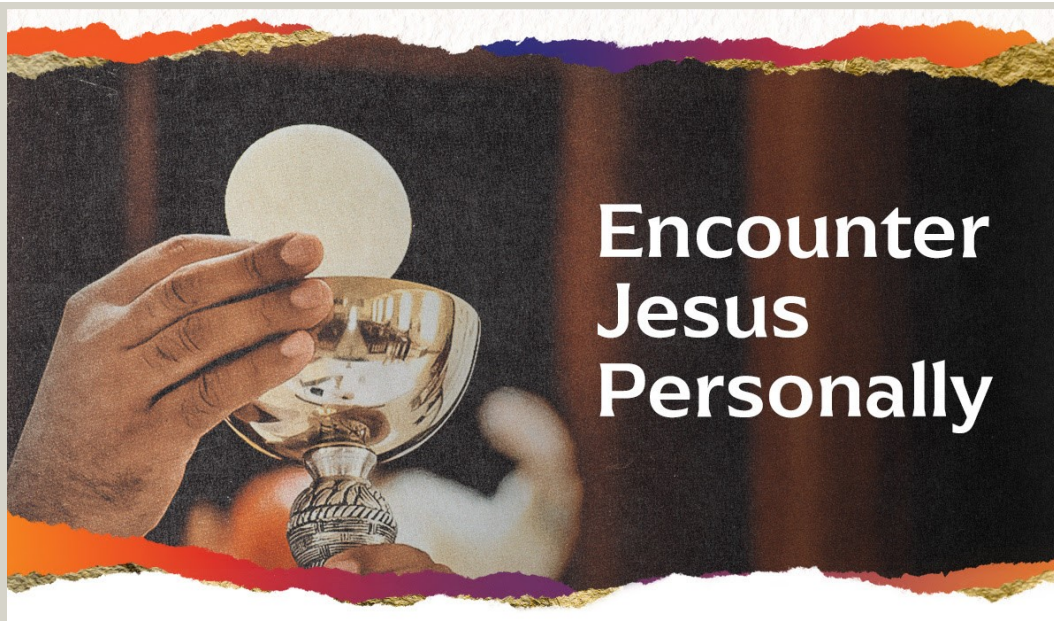

For Your Safety

JGS has a gas stove and several gas fireplaces. Natural gas is a colorless, odorless fuel. For safety reasons, a chemical odorant called mercaptan is added for easy detection. This odorant has a distinctive “rotten egg” type scent. Natural gas odors should be reported right away. If you smell this odor, alert others and leave the area immediately, leave the doors open as you exit. Do not try to locate the source of the smell.

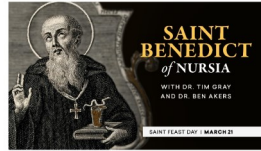

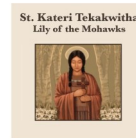
