- Awards are made directly to the student, not to the institution;
- All information provided will be treated as Personal and Confidential. It will be handled with care and discretion and your privacy will be respected. It will not be shared with anyone other than the members of the Award Committee.
- All applications are forwarded to the Award Committee only after all personal identification information has been removed by a Men's Club member not involved in the selection process. Members of the Award Committee do not know who the candidates are until after the awards are made.
